

DETAILED EXPLANATION OF THE PUBLIC TRANSPORT OFFER IN CONNECTION WITH MOUNTAIN RAILWAY TICKETS, INCL. LOCAL TRAVELCARDS, TOPCARD AND GRAUBÜNDENCARD

Public transport with mountain railway included in Davos & Klosters

(depending on the opening of the winter season)

TARIFF ASSOCIATION DAVOS & KLOSTERS

A new solution has been agreed for Davos Klosters Mountains tickets and season tickets. The tickets will be valid with restrictions in zones 400, 410, 420 and 430 of the Davos and in zones 200 and 210 of the Klosters fare network.

DESCRIPTION

Extent of use:

- Davos fare network zones 400, 410, 420, 430 (Davos Laret to Davos Glaris with Pischabahn) on VBD, PostBus and RhB (2nd class)
- Klosters fare network zones 200, 210

Period of validity:

- During the operating hours of the mountain railways

Restrictions:

- Is limited to the outward and return journeys to the valley stations of the DKM mountain railways while taking part in winter sports.
- Day or half-day tickets are only valid on the day to a certain extent.
- A subsequent refund/payment of the travel ticket is no longer possible.
- For the use of public transport when not taking part in winter sports or during leisure time, regular tickets must be purchased e.g. annual season ticket. There are separate discounts for residents of the municipalities of Klosters and Davos (www.invia.ch/davos or www.invia.ch/klosters).

FURTHER INFORMATION

The same conditions apply to ESA, TopCard and graubündenCARD. It is important for the inspection that a valid mountain railroad ticket for the current day is available (if unsure, show the sales receipt) and that the practice of winter sports is recognizable.

Guests with a vacation residence in Davos can use public transport in Davos in zones 400, 410 and 420 with the guest card without restriction.

Guests with a vacation residence in Klosters/Saas can use public transport in Klosters in zones 200, 210 and on the RhB route Klosters - Davos Platz (2nd class) without restriction. With a valid local pass issued by the municipality of Klosters, you can also use the RhB route Klosters Platz - Davos Platz (2nd class) with the same restrictions.

SHOW SALES RECEIPT

When purchasing via a web shop or if the mountain railway ticket is loaded onto a third-party data carrier, a purchase receipt must be presented (digital or paper form). Third-party data carriers are e.g. SwissPass, credit cards or cards from other mountain railroad regions (non-exhaustive list).
